Wood sections presenting varieties of tissue can be stained in two colours by first treating with magenta, washing with spirit, then soaking in the blue dye for a few minutes, again washing with spirit and afterwards with oil of cajeput and turpentine as previously directed. In a transverse section of a stem double-stained in this manner, the vessels, wood cells, and liber tissue will be more or less red; the pith, medullary rays, and cellular tissue of the bark blue or violet.
